- 4) Dr. Santosh Rollands, President, JAAI also gave some suggestion with regards to better organization of National Congress which are as follows:
  - a) To release Concept paper on the theme and get responses.
  - b) To prepare Brochure & Logo at least six months before the event.
  - c) To give equal representation to all the Jesuit Alumni Association of Patna in Organizing Committee.
  - d) To invite at least 8 good speakers on the theme.

- e) To make a team of fully dedicated volunteers for transportation & accommodation with 3-4 Taxis & School Bus and providing accommodation for all range.
  - f) To prepare a rough budget for the event.
  - g) To start registration at least one month in advance and also to provide an option to register online on website.
  - h) To provide some kit bags along with registration to the delegates.
  - i) To release a Souvenir (at least 500 copies) to mark the occasion.
  - j) To organize an exhibition of Poster & Power Point Presentations on the theme.
- 5) Mr. J. K. Sinha, President, SXAA on behalf of SXAA expressed his gratitude to Dr Santosh Rollands for his invaluable suggestions and assured the JAAI Governing Council of a memorable National Congress 2011. He also sought full cooperation of JAAI Governing Council and member associations in successful organization of the grand event. He requested Fr. Norbet M.,SJ for providing names of some Jesuit keynote speakers on the theme i.e. 'Public – Private Partnership (PPP) for better Education'.
